

Recyclable Used Paper Products (Newspaper, cardboard, magazines, books & miscellaneous paper)

Dispose of garbage during group collections ("shudan kaishu") or at a resource warehouse at your nearest Community ("Gyosei") Center or Lifelong Learning Center for collection. (excluding Ojima Community Center)

Disposable Paper Items

Tie them together and recycle.

Miscellaneous Paper

(Containers, wrapping, and similar products with the paper mark ♻️)

Put miscellaneous paper in a paper bag or tie them together when disposing.

Disposing Cooking Oil

- Collection Points: Community ("Gyosei") Centers, Lifelong Learning Centers (excluding Ojima Community Center)
- Disposal Method: put oil from food in PET bottles or oil containers and dispose of at a collection box for used food oils.

[Attention]

- Limited to vegetable oil from your house.
- Please completely fill the container before disposing.
- Dispose of unused oil in the original container.
- Please try and refrain from throwing away foreign substances (bits of fried food, etc.) in containers.

Recyclable Small, Used House Appliances

- Collection Points: Ota City Hall, Ojima and Nitta Government Building, Community ("Gyosei") Centers, Lifelong Learning Centers
- *Dispose them in the collection boxes located on the 1F.
- Objects that can be collected: Any house appliances that can fit in the collection box (15cm length X 30cm width)

[Attention]

- Small house appliances cannot be returned after being placed in the collection box.
- Remove batteries (incl. re-chargeable batteries) before placing into the collection box. (Leave them attached if they are not removable.)
- Erase all personal data before placing into the collection box.
- Items that were taken apart cannot be collected.
- Limited to only items from your house.

Ink cartridges

- Collection Points: Ota City Hall, Ojima and Nitta Government Building, and Community ("Gyosei") Centers, Lifelong Learning Centers.
- *Please dispose of them in collection boxes located on the 1st floor.
- Objects that can be collected: Ink cartridges from all manufacturers (Recycled cartridges are also OK.)

Trash not accepted by the City

Items that need to be requested for pickup at retail stores, disposal specialists, etc.

*Please absolutely refrain from disposing at trash collection stations. Direct carry-in is also not available.

[Procedures for arranging disposal]

- Request pickup from an appliance store (requires recycling and transportation fee)
- Request from the purchased store or time of replacement.
- Request services from disposal specialist approved by the city (requires recycling and transportation fee)

[Procedures for arranging disposal]

- Request at PC recycling counter of manufacturing company for collection for products marked with PC mark
- *Laptops may be put inside a Small Home Appliance Recycling collection box if small enough.
- Bigger items and those without the PC mark may be directly taken in to Recycle Plaza.
- Inquire with ReNet Japan about having the items collected via delivery service. Apply for collection via the website (<https://www.renet.jp>).

*A delivery person will come to collect your items at the date and time you specify. If a personal computer is included in the items to be collected, the service for one box will be free of charge. Small home electronic appliances and peripheral devices can also be collected with the computer.

Business-Related Trash

Items treated as industrial waste cannot be processed by the city.

Trash generated by stores, offices, restaurants, farming, etc. cannot be disposed at neighborhood trash disposal stations.

Take business related general waste directly to either Clean Plaza or Recycle Plaza. *The disposal fee for business-related trash is ¥200 per 10kg. Business operators who require assistance may request services from general waste collection and transport specialists approved by the city.

*Some business-related trash cannot be processed by the city. Please contact the phone numbers below for more information on carry-in.

Information for Direct Carry-In

[Operating hours] ● Mon.-Fri. 8:30-12:00, 13:00-16:45
● Sat. 8:30-12:00

Closed on Sundays, holidays, and December 31-January 3.

*Regarding operation hours for the year-end period (Dec. 29 and 30), please check the Ota City newsletter "Koho Ota" or other sources.

Direct carry-in costs: ¥130 per 10kg for household trash and ¥200 per 10kg for business related trash.

*Payments only accepted in cash

- Please come with plenty of time before closing.
- Oversized Trash up to 2.5m long is accepted.
- Depending on the type of item, there is a limit to the amount that can be taken in (e.g. Tatami mat Futon, etc.).
- Make sure various types of trash are separated accordingly before bringing them into the facilities.
- When bringing in pruned branches, cut them to a size no larger than 60cm long and 10cm in diameter (excluding roots).
