

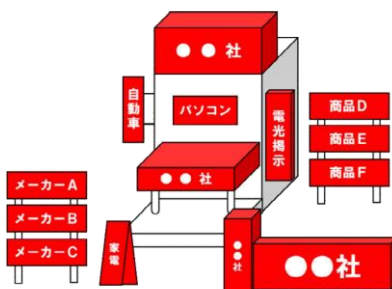

Requests when displaying outdoor signs

■ There are rules for displaying signs.

1. When putting up a sign on your own store or factory, etc.

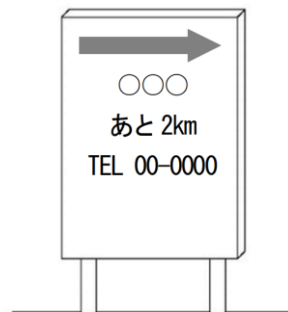
- A total of up to 15 square meters can be displayed in permitted areas “*Kyoka Chiiki*,” and up to a total of 10 square meters in prohibited areas “*Kinshi Chiiki*.”
- If the total surface exceeds 15 square meters in the permitted area, a permit from the city is required.



*Calculate the sum of the **red** area / surface.

2. When erecting a signboard along a road to advertise a store or to guide people to the store.

- A permit from the city is required.



Notes: There are rules regarding size, height, etc. depending on the location and type of signage, so please consult with the division below in advance.

After receiving a permit, it must be renewed every three years, and a permit sign (sticker) is issued each time.

We will send you information when it is time to renew. If you do not have a permit, please apply for one as soon as possible.

■ Making sure they are displayed safely.

Signs are exposed to rain, wind, and strong sunlight, and may be at increased risk of falling or collapsing. Check them periodically to ensure their safety.
