**Eligibilities:** Those who have a vaccination ticket in hand and meet all of the following criteria

- Completed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> COVID-19 vaccination
- 12 years of age or older as of the date of vaccination\*<sup>Note</sup>

\*<sup>Note</sup>: Only Pfizer vaccines are available for ages 12 to 17. Please check when you make the appointment.

## Frequently Asked Questions regarding the Vaccination

### 1. Can I receive COVID-19 vaccine and other vaccines at the same time?

Yes, you can be vaccinated with influenza vaccine at the same time, but not with other vaccines. A two-week interval is needed between COVID-19 vaccine and the other vaccines.

### 2. How long does it take for a vaccination certificate to be issued for the National Travel Assistance Program?

Certificate of Vaccination or Vaccination Record Certificate can be used as proof of vaccination instead, however, if you have lost it, a vaccination certificate can be issued on the same day at the control office below.

### 3. I have lost my vaccination ticket. Can I still receive the vaccination even if I do not have it?

No. You must have a ticket in order to receive the vaccine. If you do not have it due to loss or damage, you will need to apply for a re-issuance. For details, please contact the control office (☎ 0276-55-3160).
