■ Plan Overview

<u>Eligibilities:</u> People aged 18 years old and over who have completed their first or second vaccination (initial vaccination) and who are at least 6 months for 65 years old and older, or 7 months for 64 years old and younger after completing their second vaccination.

<u>Vaccination Methods:</u> Individual or group vaccination

Booking:

Individual Vaccination: Those aged 65 and over should receive a notice with the date and time specified by post, while other residents should contact their healthcare provider directly.

Note: Vaccination for people who are in elderly facilities are date and time specific.

> Group Vaccination: Those aged 65 and over and other residents should book by online (LINE) or phone.

■ Individual Vaccination

The city will coordinate with medical institutions and specify the date and time of vaccination in advance. Those who are eligible for the vaccination will be sent a "Vaccination Appointment Notice (Sesshu Shitei Tsuchi)" in addition to a vaccination ticket. The third vaccination can be given at the designated medical institution on the designated date and time.

Eligibilities: People who have been vaccinated at a medical institution in the city.

■ Municipal Group Vaccination

Pre-vaccination screening questionnaire with vaccination ticket will be sent to those who are eligible in late January. You will need your vaccination ticket to make an appointment. Please book for it after you receive it.

Capacity: Approximately 200 people

<u>Eligibilities:</u> People who are aged 65 or over (excluding people who are vaccinated in medical facilities)

■ Prefectural Group vaccination "Tomo Wakuchin Sesshu Center" (Yasuraoka-Cho 51 in Ota City)

Eligibilities: People who meet the following requirements

- live, work or study in one of the nine municipalities (Ota, Kiryu, Tatebayashi, Midori, Itakura, Meiwa, Chiyoda, Oizumi, and Ora) in Tomo area
- have pre-vaccination screening questionnaire with vaccination ticket
- be at least 18 years of age at the time of booking
