

Application Procedures for Receiving Child-Rearing Allowance "Jidou Fuyo Teate"

For those who fulfill the following qualifications and haven't applied the allowance yet, please add the necessary documents and proceed with the procedures.

Allowance Qualifications

Single-parent mothers who have custody of their child, single-parent fathers who have custody of their child and share the same finances, or other individuals who have taken child-rearing responsibilities in place of the mother and father, who has children not exceeded the first March 31st after reaching the age of 18 (or age of 20 in the case the child has a certain disability stipulated in the government ordinance) and qualify one of the following conditions.

- · Parents had their marriage annulled (also includes de facto relationships)
- · Father or mother has passed away
- Father or mother has a certain degree of disability (Having a degree of disability equivalent of grade 1 certified by National Pension Act)
- Father or mother is missing
- · Abandoned by the father or mother for over 1 year
- · Father or mother has received a Domestic Violence Protective Order by court
- · Mother has conceived without getting married (Affiliated children can also receive allowance)
- · Father or mother has been arrested for over 1 year
- Parents are unknown (orphaned children, etc.)

Subsidies for Spaying/Neutering of Dogs and Cats

Amount of Subsidy

Female dogs: maximum of ¥5,000 per dog Female / male cats: maximum of ¥3,000 per cat Conditions

- Female dogs (must be registered and have received a FY2020 vaccination shot for rabies) and female/male cats owned by Ota City residents.
- All household members must not have any municipal taxes (including National Health Insurance taxes) in arrears.

How to Apply: Bring document certifying the completion of surgical procedure, bankbook and inkan seal, to the Ota City Hall Environmental Policy Division (5F) by March 31, 2021 (Wed.).

- * Subsidies will not be provided for surgical procedures conducted in past fiscal years.
- * Provision of subsides will end once the budget meets its capacity.

Preparation for the vaccination of COVID-19 is underway! ! The vaccination is not compulsory.

Ota city will conduct proper vaccination of COVID-19 according to the vaccination priority stipulated by Japanese government. From mid-March onwards, we will send a coupon ticket (vaccination ticket) which is necessary to receive vaccination, to subjects sequentially from elderlies above the age of 65.

 Vaccination Priority:
 ①Healthcare professionals
 ②Elderlies above the age of 65

 ③Citizens with primary illnesses/ Citizens under the age of 64

 ※This priority might be subdivided on the basis of the situation of vaccine supply.

ON'L FORGELL Disposal Procedures

Owners of automobiles, light motor vehicles, bikes, etc. and so forth must complete the procedures of registration if they are moving out of Ota. They need to complete registrations (*"Touroku no Henko"*) to change address, etc. at their newly relocated city. If the vehicle has

been sold, traded-in, etc., paperwork involving change of ownership ("Meigi no Henko") must be submitted.

Paperwork involving vehicle disposal (*"Haisha"*) is required when a vehicle is no longer in use because it is broken, dismantled, etc. If vehicle owners have not done the paperwork, they will be taxed with those vehicles even if you do not (or cannot) use them any longer.

Vehicle owners will be taxed with a (light) motor vehicle tax on April 1st. Taxes will be made to owners **as of April 1st**, so please make sure to submit all the required documents beforehand (i.e. any changes in information, vehicle disposal, etc.).
