<u>National Fire Prevention Autumn Campaign (until 15 Nov.)</u>

Fires are more likely to occur during this part of the season.

Make sure you take the proper precautions in order to protect yourself and your belongings.

Seven Points for Safeguarding Life

- Never lying in bed / fall asleep with a lit cigarette.
- Use heaters at a safe distance **away** from flammable objects.
- Shut off the gas stoves in your kitchen anytime you are away.
- In order to prevent late evacuations, install a smoke detector in your house.
- Use bedding, clothing, and curtains made of flame-retardant material.
- Have a fire extinguisher, etc. in the house to put out fires while they are still small and containable.
- Have a cooperative system that helps elderlies and people with disabilities in the neighborhood when there is a fire.

Important Measure - Place a smoke detector and check it regularly.

All households are required to have a smoke detector "Jutakuyou Kasai Keihouki" installed in their house, so please make sure to set up a smoke detector in your house to protect you and your family. Smoke detectors should be periodically checked to ensure that they will and are functioning correctly.

Individual Resident Tax Reforms

In Fiscal Year 2021 (Reiwa 3), individual resident tax is going to be reformed. Many residents' tax amounts are not going to be effected, however filling methods will change from this year for year-end adjustments "Nenmatsu Chosei" or final income tax returns "Kakutei Shinkoku," so please be careful when you file these in.

Major Changes

- · Changes from deductions for Employment Income, Public Pensions, etc. to Basic Exemption
- · Establishing Exemption of Amount of Income Adjustment
- · Reform of Single Parents and Widow's Exemption

Establishing single parents' deductions (deduction amount: 300,000 yen)

If you are a single parent and apply all of the requirements below, you are eligible for "Hitori-oya Koujo (Single Parents' Deductions)" regardless of your marriage history or gender.

- ✓ Having a child who lives in the same household (limited to a child whose amount of all income* is 480,000 yen or less) *income (the amount remaining after subtracting necessary expenses from income)
- ✓ Income of parent is 5,000,000 yen or less.
- ✓ Not in a de facto marriage

Reform of Widow Deductions

Widows who have been eligible for income deductions previously but who do not meet the criteria above will continue to be eligible for the deduction (deduction amount: 260,000 yen) if your total income are 5,000,000 yen or less.

<u>Issuing Deduction Certificates Required for Year-End</u> Adjustments and Final Income Tax Returns

The Social Insurance Premium (national pension contributions) Deduction Certificate "Shakai Hoken Ryou (Kokumin Nenkin Hokenryo) Koujo Shoumeisho" will be mailed from Japan Pension Service if you paid in national pension contributions between Jan. 1st and Sep. 30th, 2020. Please store them in a safe place when you receive it.


