Eligible Children: 3 ~ 5 years old (as of April 1st, 2021)

Note 2: Public kindergartens are limited to children who live in Ota City.

**Note 3:** Some kindergartens have extended hours of daycare service "Azukari Hoiku," or some of Early Childhood Education and Care Centers "Nintei Kodomo-en" has a column on the application for children between 0 and 2 years old needing childcare.

<u>Application</u>: Please fill out your application form and apply at the kindergarten directly from September 1st (Tuesday), 2020.

# Chest X-ray (Tuberculosis / Lung Cancer) Medical Examinations in FY 2020

Please make sure to bring your consultation tickets "Jushinken" and barcode sticker.

- Eligible persons: individuals aged 40 and over as of March 31st, 2021
- Exam details: medical consultation, chest x-ray exam and sputum test is eligible for these whose number of cigarettes smoked per day multiplied by the numbers of years that they have smoked is 600 or more.

**Note:** Examinees cannot only take the sputum test. In the case blood sputum is found in the last six months, a medical checkup at a medical facility is recommended. Please come in wearing clothes that you can take an exam easily and does not have any metal or plastic materials.

- Fees: chest x-ray ¥500 (free for individuals 65 and over); sputum test ¥500 (free for individuals 70 and over)

  Note: Individuals who receive social welfare or households exempt from paying Municipal Inhabitant Tax (all the members must be exempted) in this fiscal year will be exempt if you apply on the exam day. (Personal-Seal "Inkan" needed for the application)
- Period: From September 1st (Tue.), 2020 to December 18th (Fri.), 2020
- Location and Operation hours: Please refer to the first page of Guide for Examinations "Kenshin no Goannai" in the Ota newspaper "Kouho" (August 1st, 2020 edition). (Only in Japanese)

\*The exam dates may be changed or cancelled to prevent the spread of Covid-19.
