Reception 13 : 30 Starts at 14 : 00 Ends at 16 : 00
2. For : Junior high school students and their parents from foreign countries who live in Ota City
3. Place : Ota-shi Kuai Community “Gyosei” Center (1st floor)

4. Capacity : 30 families (student and either their mother or father)
Those who are willing to participate in the guidance: Fill out the application form and turn it to your school. Due date: July 30th (Thursday)
5. Fee : 300yen 
6. Uniform : Students must wear their summer uniform.
7. What to bring: Face masks
(All the participants must wear a face mask at the meeting.)

If you have any symptoms of a cold or a temperature higher than 37°C, please refrain from attending the meeting.
