Garbage Disposal Facility is in "State of Emergency."



If it continues, the facility cannot process garbage.

The maximum permissible quantity: 330 tons per day

However, last year the facility received approximately 37 tons per day more than the limit. (367.8 tons last year)

Household garbage has been increasing over the years.

The situation gets worse if disasters happen or if people are required to stay at home.

If this continues... → The amount of garbage that we cannot process will increase.

⇒The city may not be able provide garbage collection service.

Please cooperate reducing garbage.

Your cooperation is needed to help to reduce 37 tons of garbage generated in the city every day.

e.g.

To reduce 37 tons,

Reduce about 400g per household per day, which is approximately three bananas.

Things that you can do straight away

- ●Get rid of as much water as possible from your food waste.
- Separate paper and plastic and recycle them.
