Let's Prevent Heat Stroke!

The hot weather will continue, so please look after yourself to prevent heat stroke.

Be attentive to the temperature and humidity, and take measures against heat stroke by constantly hydrating your body with water. In particular, children and elderly are more prone to heat stroke, so please pay extra attentions.

Preventing Heat Stroke:

- *Avoid the heat *Dress in clothes that will keep you cool *Drink liquids frequently
- •Be attentive of days that become suddenly hot •Be prepared and well-equipped for the heat
- Rest well and be healthy

Symptoms of heat stroke:

- Initial symptoms include complaints about pain in your arm/leg muscles and involuntary stiffness in your muscles
- Complaints about feeling sick with body heaviness, feeling sick, headaches and dizziness will follow and develop
- Typical symptoms include a lack of concentration from lightheadedness and absentmindedness
- If you start to stop sweating and your skin becomes red and dry, your body becomes unable to adjust its body temperature, and continues to rise. This can be life-threatening.
- Heat stroke does not always develop when you are strenuously exercising under the scorching sun, but can occur by staying in rooms or cars with no air conditioning for long periods of times, especially for infants and elderly.
- If you call for someone and their response is slow, call **119** immediately.

First Aid Treatment for Heat Stroke:

Move to a cool, breezy place in the shade or room with air-conditioning. Remove clothes and cool your body.

Apply for Exemptions (Deferment) of Contributions for National Pension Insurance **EVERY YEAR**.

Exemptions or deferments (for under 50 years old) from contribution payments are available to those who have low income and are having difficulties making National Pension Insurance payments. You can apply up to 2 years and one month before of unpaid contributions when you apply. The period that you have been exempted from will be added to the entitlement period of the receiving pension (pension amount will not be added).

Application for the Exemptions of the Contribution System

You may also be exempt from contribution payments if the previous year's income of you, your spouse (including a spouse living separately), and the head of household are lower than the standard or is unemployed. If your application for exemption is granted, you can be qualified for either full-amount-exemption, 3/4-amount-exemption, half-amount-exemption, or 1/4-amount-exemption. If you fail to pay the remaining contribution amount due, it will be considered to be a non-payment rather than partial exemption, causing you to be unable to receive the pension.

Application for Deferred Contribution Payments

If you (must be below 50 years of age) and your spouse's (including a spouse living separately) previous year's income is lower than the standard or is unemployed, you are eligible for deferred contribution payments if your application is approved.

Period of approval: From now till June 2020

*Individuals who were exempted of the full amount or deferred for their previous fiscal year's portion can re-apply (application renewal) beforehand (excluding cases due to unemployment).

Things to bring

ID (driver's license, Resident "Zairyu" Card, etc.), Individual Notification Card or Individual Number "My number" Card, personal seal "Inkan" ** If you are applying due to unemployment, you need to bring your Employment Insurance Qualification Certificate "Koyou Hoken Jyukyu Shikakushasho" or your letter of resignation "Rishokuhyo" from your employer.

Applying and Renewing for an Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application

If you have a high-cost medical expense (copayment), the Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application "Gendogaku Ninteisho" is a certificate that limits payments made at hospitals.

Please re-apply and renew when they expire.

Eligible persons (must be paid all of the National Insurance tax):

- under 70 years
- 70~74 years old in a household exempt from municipal taxes
- *Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application and Reduction of the Standard Amount of Patient Liability for exempt households from municipal taxes.
- *Individuals enrolled in health insurances other than the municipality's (Kokuho) must apply and receive their certificate from their respective medical insurer.
