# **Be Careful of Wild Boars!!**



Recently, we have been receiving many complaints regarding damages (to plantation/rice fields, etc.) caused by wild boars in the surrounding areas of Hachioji Hill, Kanayama Mountain, and at the riverbed area of Watarase River. Areas around Kanayama Mountain in particular are seeing wild boars appear in the evening and at night, involved in even several car accidents. In order to prevent further damage there are currently groups who are licensed and trained to capture wild boars, but due to their increase in population they have not been able to completely prevent all the damage caused by wild boars. Please read the following precautionary points below in order to prevent injury/damages!

### **Precautionary Points**

- ★ Wild boars are normally active from sundown and at dawn, but are certainly not limited to only being active during the nighttime
- ★They usually eat vegetables, insects, worms, snakes, etc.
- ★Wild boars may damage rice fields and vegetable plantations for food
- ★They are usually timid and do not attack people, but it can become aggressive if it is provoked
- ★If you encounter a wild boar, do not turn your back and run. While walking backwards, give the boar enough room to run away.

#### If they are provoked/agitated, and there is a chance they may charge at you...

- ★Conceal yourself under the shadow of a car, or run away to a high location.
- ★If you have an umbrella, it is said that hiding your feet with it can be effective as well. If you are hiking...
- ★Make sure you have a bell or a radio on at all times; it will make your presence obvious and scare away any wild boars in the area. ★Avoid taking dogs if they have a tendency of provoking other animals.

IT IS STRICKLY PROHIBITED TO HUNT WITHOUT A HUNTING LICENSE (permission is required)!!
