

# LET'S PREVENT HEAT STRO

Days with high temperatures will continue, so please be aware of heat stroke! Be attentive to the temperature and humidity, and try to prevent heat stroke by constantly hydrating your body with water. In particular, children and elderlies are more prone to heat stroke, so please be careful!

## Preventing Heat Stroke:

- Avoid the heat
- Think of how you dress
- Keep in mind to hydrate and drink liquids frequently
- Be attentive of days that become suddenly hot
- Be prepared and well-equipped for the heat
- Take care of your body

## Symptoms of heat stroke:

- Initial symptoms include complaints about pain in your arm/leg muscles and involuntary stiffness in your muscles
- Complaints about feeling sick with body heaviness, feeling nauseous, headaches and dizziness will follow and develop Typical symptoms include a lack of concentration from lightheadedness and absentmindedness
- If you start to stop sweating and your skin becomes red and dry, your body becomes unable to adjust its body temperature, which continues to rise. This can be life-threatening!
- If you call for someone and your response is slow, call 119 immediately.
- Heat stroke does not always develop when you are strenuously exercising under the scorching sun, but can occur by staying in rooms or cars with no air conditioning for long periods of times, especially with infants and elderlies.

## First Aid Treatment for Heat Stroke: 🗘

- Move to a cool, breezy place in the shade or room with air-conditioning
- Remove clothes and cool your body

Upcoming Heisei 29 (FY2017) Payment Deadlines for Municipal Tax

The Municipal and Prefectural Inhabitant Tax (2<sup>nd</sup> period) and National Health Insurance Tax (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is due on

August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017 (Thursday),

## Renewing and Applying for an Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application

If you have a high-cost medical expense (copayment/deductible), the Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application "Gendogaku Ninteisho" is a certificate that limits payments made at the counter to a specified ceiling-amount.

#### Details are specified below:

Individuals under 70 years or 70~74 year olds in a household exempt from municipal taxes (Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application and Reduction of the Standard Amount of Patient Liability for exempt households) are eligible. Patients must present their eligibility certificate at the counter. In addition, certificates must be renewed when they expire (new certificates are valid until July 2018). Households cannot have any National Health Insurance taxes unpaid or unaccounted.

Individuals enrolled in other than the municipality's insurance must apply and receive their certificate from their respective ×: medical insurer.

# <u>Preventive Vaccination for</u> <u>Measles-Rubella Combined (MR)</u>

For those that have not received their measles-rubella vaccination, please have them administered within the specified deadlines. Vaccination shots administered after the specified deadlines will be responsible for paying the full amount (approximately 12,000 yen).

#### Measles-Rubella Combined (MR)

1<sup>st</sup> cycle – infants 12 ~ 23 months old; 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle – older children born between April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011 ~ April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012.


Please visit your primary care medical facility by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 for those receiving a 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle vaccination

The required period of contribution payments to receive old age basic pension has been reduced from **25 to 10 years**. Individuals that have become eligible to receive this due to the revised system of the Japan Pension Service will be sent a yellow envelope (A4 size) with an application inside. For those that have not yet completed the procedures to claim your pension should schedule an appointment by calling the Nenkin Dial, and complete the required procedures at the Pension Office promptly. Individuals that are only enrolled in National Pension (category 1) may also complete the procedures at the Medical Welfare and Pension Division (Ota City Hall, 1<sup>st</sup> floor).
