School Meal Subsidies for 2nd and 3rd Born Children Onw

Starting in April, families will be eligible to receive subsidies for their 2nd (50% reduction) and 3rd born child onward (100% exemption). Households must apply to all of the following conditions below:

Raising 2 or more children born from April 2nd, 1997 onwards.

Applicant and children eligible for exemptions must have an address within Ota City.

Applicant's family must all be enrolled in medical insurance.

- Municipal taxes must be paid and accounted for.
- For those with unpaid taxes, please consult with their respective division.

Assistance Program Application Period for Raising your 3rd Child Onwar

We are accepting applications for childcare exemption fees for the months of April onwards.

For those who are already receiving assistance need to follow the instructions on your application that were sent through post mail in mid-January.

Application Period: until February 24 (Fri.) (excludes weekends and holidays)

Conditions for Applying (all conditions must be met)

Raising 3 or more children born on April 2nd, 1997 onwards (April 2, 1996 onwards for those who go to private kindergartens outside of Ota City)

Applicant and children eligible for exemption must have an address within Ota City.

Applicant's family must all be enrolled in medical insurance.

Municipal taxes must be paid and accounted for.

Residents who have been living in Ota for under 1 year are eligible for exemptions this application period. For those that already have children enrolled in childcare facilities may also apply for exemption if they were not eligible.

Things to bring: applicant's copy of their Health Insurance and "Inkan"-seal.

in National Health

The National Health Insurance (Kokuho) benefits those who are self-employed, employed in agriculture, and individuals in companies who do not offer health insurance. It also provides insurance for unemployed individuals.

Individuals who are currently enrolled in National Health Insurance may also be recognized as a dependent of their family's Social Health Insurance or Health Insurance Association if certain conditions are met.

The conditions (dependents' annual income, relationship with the person enrolled in Social Health Insurance, living arrangements, etc.) for acceptance may differ according to their place of employment. Please consult with their place of employment.

X A survey asking your current state of affairs may be sent to some households. We kindly appreciate your cooperation. Please proceed with the withdrawal of your National Health Insurance at Ota City Hall if you are already enrolled in your employer's health insurance.

Things to bring: both insurance cards, "inkan"-seal and personal identification (Resident "Zairyu" Card, driver's license, etc.), and My Number (Notification) Card.

Notification required when using your National Health Insurance (Kokuho) Card to Cover Medical Fees caused by accidents, etc.

Injuries from traffic accidents and fights caused by the third party will be temporarily covered with an advanced payment by your National Health Insurance, and later billed to the perpetrator of the incident. Please make sure to file a notification as soon as possible. If you fail to submit one, you will be responsible for refunding 70~90 percent of the medical bill.

Required items for your notification

- 1. Third Party Injury and Illness Notification "Daisansha Koui Shoubyou Todokede"
- 2. Status report for accident "Jiko Hassei Jyoukyou Houkokusho"
- 3. Memorandum (victim) "Nensho"
- 4. Traffic Accident Statement (certificate)
- 5. Health insurance card, "inkan"-seal, personal identification (Resident "Zairyu" Card, etc.)
- \times Items 1-3 are available at the National Health Insurance Division (City Hall, 1st floor)

Examples of Third Party Acts

- Injuries caused from traffic accidents, another person's pet, unjust violence; physical contact resulting in injury from skiing, snowboarding, etc.; food poisoning from a restaurant, etc.

If you are in an accident involving a third party...

- Promptly contact the National Health Insurance and police
- Check the other person's address, name, telephone number, etc. (driver's license, auto insurance for traffic accidents, etc.)
- When going in for your medical consultation, let your doctor know that your injury/sickness was caused by a third party.

Make sure to submit a notification to the National Health Insurance before receiving any kind of settlement! If you receive money, etc. from a third party, you may not be able to receive funds from the National Health Insurance for your medical bill. If you have reached a settlement, promptly submit a copy of the document; be sure to contact Kokuho when completing or canceling your medical treatment as well.


