Renewing and Applying for an Eligibility Certificate for Limited Costs

In the case a high-cost medical expense (treatments, hospitalization, etc.), the Eligibility Certificate for Limited Costs "Gendogaku Ninteisho" enables patients to pay a specified, lower amount. Details are specified belowed:

- 1) The person subscribed to the health insurance must be under 70 years old.
- 2) Household does not have any National Health Insurance taxes unpaid and unaccounted for.
- 3) Sumit an application at:
 *Ota City Hall National Health Insurance Division "Kokumin Kenkou Hoken-Ka" 1F-Counter 16
 *Community "Gyousei" Centers (Ojima, Kizaki, Ikushina, Watauchi, Yabuzukahonmachi)
- 4) You must renew the certificate when it expires (new certificates are valid until July 2017).
- 5) After applying for the eligibility certificate, patients must present it at the reception desk of the hospitals/clinics.
- 6) What to bring: National Health Insurance card, My Number Notification/Card, inkan-seal, and identification.
- Persons who are enrolled to other health insurances such as, Social Insurance "Shakai Hoken" and others, must apply and receive their certificate from their respective health insurance company.

Deferred Payment and Contribution Postponement System for National Pension Insurance Tax

Deferred Payment System

If you have unpaid contributions for your pension within the past 5 years, it is still possible to increase your future pension by paying the amount due. There is also a chance for those that could not receive a pension to receive one by utilizing the deferred payment system. For those that have forgotten National Pension Insurance contributions within the past 5 years, please take advantage of this system! **This system can be utilized until September 2018.*

Contribution Postponement System

Individuals who are aged <u>under 50</u> are now eligible for this system, which allows you to postpone your contribution payments. The tax payer and dependent (excludes head of household) are subject to income screenings. Individuals who were not eligible for the contribution exemption may be eligible for this. If payment for these taxes prove difficult, please make sure to apply for this system!
