Commitments to Garbage Disposa



There is a designated date and area (Trash Disposal Station) according to regions for disposal collection. Please follow accordingly.

2) Garbage Disposal

1) Designated Date

Residents have until 8:30am to dispose of trash for collection. Any trash disposed of after the appointed time may not be collected until the next designated date for pick up. Animals, especially crows, will dig through any trash left behind and make a mess of the disposal station. Please be courteous of others and dispose of trash on time!

3) Designated Location

Trash Disposal Stations were voluntarily determined by each region (apartments, condominiums, etc.) and does not mean anyone can place garbage at any select station. Illegal disposal (littering) is not only inconvenient to the proprietor and surrounding neighbors, but it may also adversely affect the living environment of that area. Let's throw away trash at your original designated station!

4) Sorting and Separation of Garbage

By sorting garbage correctly, there is a lot of trash that can be recycled and reused for city resources. Correctly sorting and separating garbage leads to the effective reuse of resources, reduction of waste, and most importantly, efficient development of the community.

5) Designated Garbage Bags

There are designated "Burnable Items" and "Non-Burnable Items" trash bags that are used for collection. Any other garbage bag utilized will not be collected. Please always make sure to use the designated garbage bags. *Please use the processing seal for oversized garbage*

6) Do Not Mix Garbage Items.

Please <u>do not</u> mix burnable and non-burnable items! Disposing items composed of metal and aluminum, such as compressed gas cans, spray cans, etc. with burnable items could cause injuries to the workers collecting trash and damage to operating incinerators. Please separate and dispose trash by using the designated garbage bags.

When's the last time you received a health checkup? It's important to regularly take examinations to safeguard your body from any potential ailments. Take advantage of this opportunity now and go get your checkup!

Persons applicable for a checkup will receive a ticket "jushinken" by mail (if you did not receive one please call below).

For detailed information on matters such as schedules for checkups and medical institutions, please refer to the enclosed envelope "kenshin no goannai".

*Checkups are conducted throughout the year from May~November

Available Examinations: chest x-ray (tuberculosis, lung cancer); stomach, colon, prostate, cervical, and breast cancer osteoporosis; hepatitis virus; gum disease; regular and specified health checkups.

- It has been at least 1 year since registering one's Basic Resident Registration Card, and lived in Ota for at least 1 year (either the husband or wife) from day of application
- Receiving treatment from a doctor, or a designated medical institution for special infertility treatments
- No tax payments in arrears (taxes payments must be all accounted for)
- Must be enrolled in medical health insurance

Providing Stipends for Low-Income Elderlies

Scheduled to send application forms to persons that may be subject to receive a stipend near the end of May

Please be cautious of potential bank transfer fraud and identity theft (fraud)

Eligible persons: persons subject to 2015's temporary welfare stipend (benefit) and were born on or before 4/1/1952. They must also have had their resident registration done by 1/1/15 in Ota, as well as not been imposed by the municipal tax in 2015.

Persons such as residents who are not paying the municipal tax but are receiving support (from individuals paying the taxes), and recipients of welfare are not subject to receive the stipend

Subsidies for Complete Health Checkups for Persons with

National and Older Senior Citizens Health Insurance

Persons above 40 under either insurance are subject to both specified and comprehensive medical checkups, but may only use the granted subsidy for one examination.

Types of Medical Checkups: one day, overnight stay, and brain examinations (dental exams can be combined)

Examination Period: June 1st 2016~Feb. 28 2017. *You may not receive a subsidy if you do not apply beforehand

Eligible Persons: Persons 35 and above (excluding persons under older senior insurance) who have no unpaid health insurance fees. Persons over 65 are not eligible for brain examinations.

Application Period: May 12~13th (Thur.-Fri.), 9am~5pm at Kuai Event "Gyousei" Center; May 16th (Mon.)~Sep. 30th (Fri.) at City Hall's National Health Insurance or Medical Welfare and Pension Division (both 1st floor)

Please bring your health insurance, seal "inkan", and special medical checkup ticket.

accination Against Rabi

Did you know that it is not only mandatory to have your dog vaccinated against rabies, but to also have your dog registered if he/she is over 91 days old? Take this opportunity to have your dog vaccinated and registered!

Vaccination period: Until May 22, 2016 (Sun) (can also be taken at veterinary clinics)

Cost: Vaccination = ¥3,400 (for dogs already registered) / Vaccination & Registration = ¥6,400

Items to bring: Notice on Rabies Vaccination (dogs are accepted for vaccination even if you did not recieve a notice; please come to the places specified direcetly).
