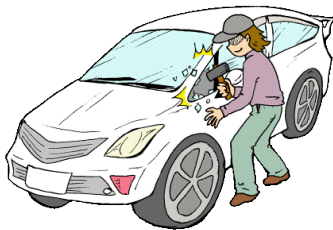
PREVENTION OF OUTDOOR THEFT

There were many occurrences of vehicle break-ins from residences and apartment parking lots in Ota City around this time last year. The number of reports of car break-ins from attempts of stealing the belongings inside the vehicles, as well as auto parts such as; car's wheels, GPS devices and others have been increasing.

The police have been reinforcing their patrols throughout the day and night. Although, we must take precautions on a daily basis in order to prevent becoming a target of these incidents.

Measurements to prevent outdoor thefts

Prevention of car break-ins due to belongings left in the vehicle:



- ✓ Make sure to close all windows and lock the doors of your car when walking away from it
- ✓ Do not leave any valuables or belongings unattended in the interior of your vehicle.

Prevention of auto parts thefts:

- ✓ To prevent having your GPS device or wheels stolen, please secure them by fastening them with special anti-theft screws or bolts.
- ✓ Do not leave tires outside that were taken from your car, it is advised to either keep them indoors or in an outdoor shed that locks.



Prevention of bicycle thefts:

- ✓ Make sure to lock your bicycle when parking it.
- ✓ Make sure to double lock it when using a security chain.
