How to Protect Yourself from the Influenza Epidemic

DAILY PREVENTIVE MEASURES YOU CAN TAKE

Wash your hands (using water and soap) and gargle regularly;

- ★ Wear a gauze mask (cover your nose well too);
- ☆ Avoid crowds;
- ☆ Maintain humidity in rooms at 50%~60%;
- ★ Eat a well-balanced diet and get enough sleep.



How to be considered of other when coughing/sneezing:

Large quantities of viruses are contained in droplets that fly from coughing and sneezing. This "airborne droplet transmission" is the primary route for the spread of Influenza.

- If you are about to cough or sneeze, please cover your mouth and nose first with a mask or tissue and distance yourself from others by 2 meters or more beforehand.
- ☆ Dispose of tissues in a trash box with a lid and wash your hands well.

Proper daily actions are essential for preventing infections. Once the preventive measures are done correctly, you and your family can protect their health from getting influenza.

Gunma Prefecture Volunteer Medical Interpreters are available

The Gunma prefectural government trains and dispatches medical interpreters to hospitals in order to make sure its foreign residents are able to see a doctor when they need without worrying about their ability to speak Japanese. These interpreters translate on a volunteer basis for the Gunma residents who are not able to communicate sufficiently with the doctors and other medical professionals in Japanese.

If you need an interpreter, please ask the hospital staff or social worker for an interpreter. These services are available at Prefectural Hospitals "*Kenritsu Byoin*" and at 28 medical institutions that have an agreement with the prefectural government. The translations available are in **English**, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese, Vietnamese, Tagalog, Indonesian, Korean, Nepali and Thai. Although, you or the hospital will be required to pay JPY2,000 to your interpreter as a transportation fee. ***Before your visit, please contact the** *Jinkendanjo-Tabunka Kyousei-Ka* (contact information below) to learn what hospital provides the interpreter services.

Guideline to properly enroll in the National Health Insurance "Kokumin Kenkou Hoken"

The National Health Insurance benefits those who are self-employed, agriculture workers or are not eligible to be members of any employment-based health insurance program. Also, those who are unemployed must enroll into the National Health Insurance System.

Those who are currently enrolled into the National Health Insurance can be recognized as a dependent if someone in the household is enrolled into the Social Health Insurance or Health Insurance Association.

The circumstances may differ based on the health insurance system used by the employment place. Please consult with your employer if someone corresponds to the dependents' standards due to their annual income, relationship between the persons concerned, cohabitation and others.

X We may send a notice of the Current Situation Survey to some households. We kindly appreciate your cooperation.

<u>Please perform the withdrawal of the National Health Insurance at Ota City Hall if your employment place has</u> <u>issued a health insurance card.</u>

Application for after school program

Ota Children Plaza "Ota-Shi Kodomo Platz" The after school program "Ota-Shi Kodomo Platz" is a program created by Ota City Hall in order to provide a safe

place in the classrooms that have not been used to benefit the households of those whose parents work outside their home by offering a place for their children to be taken care of after school. There, your child will have the opportunity to do their daily homework, get into the habit of studying, and a chance to interact with children of other ages through educational recreation activities.

Operating hours: Monday ~ Friday starting from after school until 17:45. ↔ During the Summer Vacation Period, it will start from 8:30.

- It will be closed on Sat., Sun., national holidays, during Obon period, year-end and New Year holiday.
- **Eligibility:** Elementary school students
 - The parents who work outside their home by leaving their children without supervision at home after school.
 - The parents must be able to pick up their children by 17:45.
 - According to the general rules, it is not possible to use the services only during the Summer Vacation.
- \geq Capacity: 15~40 children per classroom (The younger grade will have priority in case the numbers of applicants are above the permitted limit.)
- There is a possibility for the after school program not being available in case of not having enough applicants.
 - Fee: ¥3,000 per month (¥5,000 for the month of August)
 - Those who do not make the payments will have their tuition canceled.
- Activities content: Self-study learning and recreation time.

How to apply: The application forms are available at the Jidou Kan facilities or at Children's Facility Division \triangleright "Jidou Shisetsu-Ka" on the 3F, Counter 31 at Ota City Hall, fill in the application form and submit it in person at these facilities, until February 26(Fri.) (except Sat., Sun., and holidays)
