


We should be careful when dealing with Internet Auctions !

## **Ota Police Station**

There has been a lot of trouble after making a successful bid for auctions such as :

Items have not been sent after making the payment in an account which sellers directed. Items which were delivered to you were wrong, etc.





Popular items that are presented at an extremely cheap price ; Items that are presented in pictures which look like pictures from other catalogues.

The only contact available is the e-mail address of seller.

In particular, you should not accept offers such as ;

"How about buying items which the successful bidder had cancelled ?" Because such offers may be frauds.



1 After you are informed of the seller's address or telephone number, you should confirm by calling the seller directly and by using websites (e.g. Google Earth) to search that address.

It is safe that you choose to cash on delivery or intermediate services which are provided by the auction websites when you pay the bill.

2 Please keep a record of the information in case of a problem ;

ID, User name, member's number URL of the Auction websites Records of E-mail Records of payments, etc.





## Locking is" the key "to prevent crimes !

Get into the habit of locking your home, car, or bicycle not to become a victim of burglary, car theft, and bicycle theft.

- Whenever you go out, even for a short period of time, do not forget to close all doors and windows in your home and lock it.
- · If you are absent from your home for a long time, you should call a neighbor.
- · Do not leave your car without turning off the engine.
- · Over 70% of the cars and bicycles which were stolen in 2013 were locked.
- Make sure to park your car or bicycle at an appropriate parking area and to lock it before leaving.



## Procedures to obtain of a driver's license.

The office which you renew license and change your address on your driver's license is not at the Ota Police Station but at the Ota Traffic Safety Association !



Procedures for a reissue of a driver's license when you lose or if it was stolen.

- 1 Report lost or stolen to the Police ;
- 2 After reporting to the Police, you proceed for a reissue of your license at Ota Traffic Safety Association or Gunma General Traffic Center (Maebashi City).



Fee and time required for your reissue

Fee: 3,600 Yen

Time: Approximately 2 weeks (Ota Traffic Safety Association ) Approximately 2 hours (Gunma General Traffic Center)
