### **Children's Medical Subsidy Has Changed.**

Eligible Children

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Only in Japanese

Eligibility conditions for the subsidy were removed on October 1, and children up to high school age (until the first March 31 after reaching the age of 18) will be eligible for free medical care.

#### Application Required

For children of eligible age who do not have a Welfare Medical Expense Eligibility Certificate (pink card).

#### **Application Not Required**

For children who are high school age (The certificate number begins with 6)

A parent/guardian must bring their I.D. and the child's health insurance card and apply in person at the Medical Welfare and Pension Division (Ota City Hall 1F/Counter 12).

Methods

A new certificate will be mailed in early March 2024.

Please continue to use the certificate that you have.

### Assistance for Installation of Residential Fire Al

Fire officials will assist in the installation of fire alarms / smoke detector "Juutakuyou Kasai Keihouki." Please note that you must provide your own fire alarm. The Ota Area Fire Prevention and Safety Association "Ota Chiku Bouka Anzen Kyoukai" can arrange for an alarm at a cost of approximately 2,500 yen per unit if necessary.

Eligible households: Households consisting solely of elderly persons aged 65 and over. Application: Please bring your I.D. (driver's license, residence card, etc.) to the nearest fire station.

Part of the purchase cost will be subsidized for homebound elderly people whose hearing loss interferes with their daily life.

Subsidy amount: Up to 30,000 yen (one half of the purchase cost)

\*Only hearing aids, which are medical devices, are eligible for the subsidy; devices that 'collect' sound "Shuuonki" or 'assist' hearing "Jyochouki" which are sold as audio equipment are not.

Eligibility: Those who meet ALL of the following requirements:

- Residents of the city who are 65 years old or older and registered as residents
- ✓ NOT issued a physical disability certificate due to hearing disability
- ✓ Hearing level in both ears is from 40 to 69 dB, and is recognized by an otolaryngologist as requiring the use of hearing aids.

Note: Subsidy is limited to once per person. Those who received a grant in the previous fiscal year are not eligible for this time.

How to apply: Apply in person at the Longevity Reassurance Division or the city website by February 29 (Thursday), 2024, bringing the application form, the doctor's opinion letter (for the subsidy program), and a written estimate of the hearing aid to be purchased.

\*The application will be closed when the number of applications reaches the capacity.


