

Lost **AND** Found

Notice from the Ota Police Station:

If you LOSE something,

Go to the nearest police station (Keisatsusho), police box (Kouban) or residential police box (Chuuzaisho), and **file a report**. Reports by phone are also accepted (all calls will be in Japanese).

- ➡ If you lost something on the bus, train or store, please confirm and check with the station attendant, bus company or store clerk before filing a report with the police.
- ➡ If you lose your credit / bank card or mobile phone, please contact with your credit card company, financial institution or phone company in order to prevent illegal use.

If your cat or dog goes missing,

File a report at a public health center (Hokenjo) before reporting to the police.

(Dog owners must register their dogs at the city hall and vaccinate them against rabies every year.)

If you lose your driver's license,

File a report for a lost item at police, and complete procedure to the **Ota Traffic Safety Association (Ota Koutsuu Anzen Kyoukai)** or **Gunma General Traffic Center (Gunma Sougou Koutsuu Center)** to re-issue your driver's license (open only on weekdays).

If you FOUND a lost item,

Go through the procedures for filing a report which differ depending on the place lost items were found.

1. If an item was found on the street, please either return it to the owner, or the nearest police.

- ➡ If the owner of the lost item has been found within 7 days from filing the report, the individual who filed the report has a right to receive a reward. On the other hand, if the owner has not been found, the person who submitted the report becomes the new owner.

2. Please file reports to station attendants or store clerks for lost items found in trains, train stations or stores within 24 hours.

- ➡ In these cases, the individual who filed the report has a right to receive a reward. If the owner has not been found, the person who submitted the report becomes the new owner.

You may report lost items 24 hours a day excluding residential police boxes, Chuuzaisho.

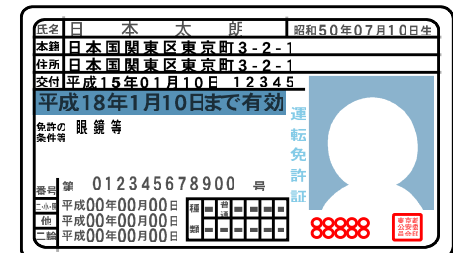
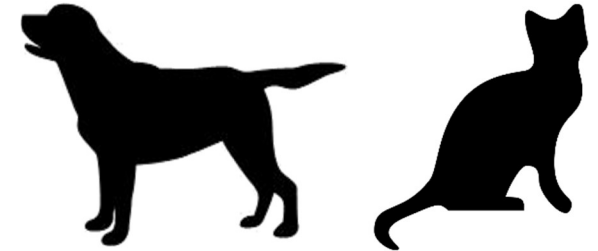
Keeping and not reporting lost items to the police is a crime!
