Reported Pregnancy in FY 2023: A card will be mailed to you after the birth of your child is confirmed. Reported Pregnancy in FY 2024: A card will be issued when the Maternal and Child Health Handbook Boshi Kenkou Techou is issued. *If you receive the medical checkup outside of Gunma Prefecture (excluding Ashikaga City), you will need to apply for the subsidy. *Please bring your Maternal and Child Health Handbook and the card when your child receive the one-month checkup.
