

#### Disnosing of Garhage at Trash Station

- 1. DAY: Put out your garbage ONLY on the collection day designated by each district or station, and follow the rules correctly to keep it clean.
- 2. TIME: Put out your garbage by 8:30AM on the collection day. If you put out after garbage has been collected, your garbage will not be collected until the next collection day, resulting in littering by crows, etc., and making the station and the surrounding area dirty.
- 3. LOCATION: Each district and apartment building has its own trash station. which is managed by the residents independently. Therefore, please strictly follow your district or building's rule and be sure to dispose of your garbage at the designated location.

\*Garbage generated by stores, offices, restaurants, agriculture, etc. can NOT be disposed of at the local trash station.

**4.** SORTING: There are many items that can be reused as resources among those considered "garbage" from households. Instead of disposing of them as garbage, please separate them to recycle and reduce the amount of garbage.

\*Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, and miscellaneous papers are collected at recycling warehouses located at community centers.

5. BAG: When disposing, be sure to put it in **designated trash bags**. Garbage placed in plastic bags such as shopping bags from supermarket, etc. will NOT be collected. The maximum amount of garbage per household is limited to approximately 2 bags per collection. \*Designated garbage bags are available at designated retailers, as well as 'Oversized Trash Disposal Sticker' which you must stick on the oversized waste when disposing.

6. Do Not MIX: If you put items that are classified as hazardous waste. such as "batteries" or "mobile batteries," in trash bags and dispose of them, it could cause accidents on incineration equipment or fires in garbage truck. Please be sure to separate these items as "hazardous trash" and deal with them correctly.

## Subsidy for Half of the test fee for **Eiken and K**a

This subsidy is for Grade 3 of Eiken Test (Test in Practical English Proficiency) and Kanken Test (The Japan Kanji Aptitude Test). You can apply for all the tests even if you take them more than once during the test / school year. Please note that provision of subsides will end once the budget meets its capacity.

Eligibilities: (1) Students enrolled in junior high schools in the city.

(2) Students residing in the city but enrolled in schools outside of the city. Note: Computer Based Testing (CBT) tests are also applicable.

#### Deadline: March 31<sup>st</sup> (Monday), 2025 (Must arrive by this date.) Methods:

- (1) If students take the test as a group at school, pay half of the fee at the time of application; if they take the test at other places, fill out the application form available on the Board of Education website and send it in person or by mail to the School Education Division, Gakkou Kyouiku-Ka (in the Ojima Government Building, Ojima Chousha (Address: 〒370-0495 Ota-Shi Kasukawa-Cho 520) in person or by mail.
- (2) Fill out the application form on the Board of Education's website and send it to the division in person or by mail.
