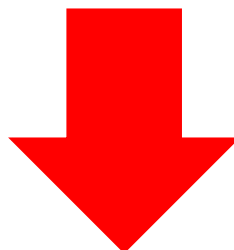
Due to the revision of the Child Allowance Act, the system will change as follows **starting with the allowance, *Jidou Teate*, for October 2024 (Transfer Month: December 2024).**

Please note that **the recipient of the child allowance is whichever parent (guardian) has the higher income.**

Eligible Children	Up to Junior High School Age Students (Up to the first March after child turns 15 years old)	Up to High School Age Students (Up to the first March after child turns 18 years old)
Amount for 3 rd and Subsequent Child	15,000-yen/month (For Junior High School Students: 10,000-yen/month)	All: 30,000-yen/month
How to Count for 3 rd and Subsequent Child	Up to High School Age Students (Up to the first March 31 after turns 18 years old)	Up to University Age Students (Up to the first March 31 after turns 22 years old)
Income Limitations	With income limit.	No income limit.
Date of Transfer	10 th of February, June, and October (3 times/year; 4 months' worth)	10 th of Even-Numbered Months (6 times/year; 2 months' worth)

If **both of the following conditions apply, this procedure is required** as it affects the amount of the allowance (see the table below).

- Having children between the ages of 19 and 22 in the current school year.
- Having 3 or more children up to age 22 in the current school year.
