#### <u>Prevent Electrical Fires After Power Cut.</u>

When power is restored after a power failure due to water-related disasters, there is a risk of fire from the electrical wiring. For your safety, please note the following.

- ☑ During a power cut, turn off all electrical equipment and unplug the power plug from the outlet.
- ☑ Turn off the circuit breaker when you leave your home during a power cut.
- ☑ When resuming power supply, check the following safety precautions **BEFORE** using electrical equipment.
  - Electrical equipment has not been damaged by water leakage, etc.
  - Wiring and cords are not damaged.
  - · There are no flammable materials nearby.
- ☑ If **smoke** is **generated** due to damage to the wiring in the wall or inside the electrical equipment, immediately turn off the circuit breaker and contact the fire department.

## **Extermination of Hornet** (Suzumebachi) **Nests**

• Eligible places: Residential houses and their land (excluding business offices and apartments)

● Expense: Free (If the nests are somewhere unusual, including inside a wall, in very high places, you need to pay some of the costs. Only Suzumebachi, Japanese yellow hornets, are subject to extermination. Other kinds of beehives or flying ones cannot be exterminated.)

● How to apply: The landowner or their family member should call the specialist (city's outsourcing corporation; Kantou Yakuhin Shoudoku Kabushikigaisha 20276-57-8859) directly. The exterminations must be witnessed, and signatures and stamps Inkan by owners are required.
