ubsidy for Wigs and Breast Prostheses

In order to support the social participation of cancer patients and help recovery, we will subsidize part of the purchase cost.

Eliaibility: People who meet ALL of the following criteria

- Registered as a resident of the city and having been recorded in the city's basic resident register for at least one year on the date of application for the subsidy
- Undergone or are currently undergoing cancer treatments
- Purchased wigs or breast prosthetic devices for hair loss or mastectomy due to cancer treatments
- No delinquency in paying municipal inhabitant tax

What to Be Subsidized: Wigs and breast prostheses*

(*Excluding accessories not included in the main unit, care products, shipping and documentation fees, etc.)

Maximum Amount: Wigs - 30,000-yen (One time per person)

Breast Prostheses - 10,000-yen (One time per person)

Application Period: Within one year from the date of purchase

How to Apply: Prepare required documents and go to one of the health centers.

(If you cannot come, please contact a center for more information.)
