

Health Checkup Target Group CHANGED.

Health checkups are now available for people who meet below from this fiscal year. Eligibility after change: People aged 20-39 years who meet both of the following criteria.

- No opportunity to have a checkup at work, etc.
- Not enrolled in the National Health Insurance.

Chest X-ray (Tuberculosis / Lung Cancer) Group Examinations



See the guide enclosed with the notification or the city website for details. <All Exams> Reservations not required. Come directly to the venue on the designated day. <Chest X-ray>

- Eligibility: Individuals aged 40 years or over (as of March 31st, 2026)
- **Co-payment:** 500-yen (free for individuals 65 years and over)

Persons who are aged 65 years or older are obliged to receive the exam under the Infectious Disease Act. <**Sputum Test>**

 Eligibility: Individuals who are aged 50 years or over and whose Brinkman Index*Note is 600 or over. (As of March 31st, 2026)

Note: Brinkman Index = (Number of cigarettes smoked per day) X (Number of years smoked)
● Co-payment: 500-yen (free for individuals 70 and over)

Individuals who are not feeling well, undergoing treatment or follow-up due to tuberculosis / lung cancer, have sputum containing blood within 6 months, or wearing insulin pumps or continuous glucose monitoring devices (if worn at the time of the visit) are not allowed to take the exam.

Mother and Child Health Program

Details on health examinations for children, maternal and child health seminars, application for subsidies for infertility treatments and treatments for recurrent miscarriages, and issuing a Maternal and Child Health Handbook *Boshi Kenkou Techou*, or other information are provided on the website.

Subsidy for Half of the test fee for **Eiken and Kanken**

This subsidy is for Eiken Test (Test in Practical English Proficiency) and Kanken Test (The Japan Kanji Aptitude Test). Students can apply for all the tests even if they take them more than once during the test / school year. Please note that provision of subsides will end once the budget meets its capacity.

Subsidized Grades:

- Elementary school students: Eiken Grade 3, Kanken Grade 3 and 5
- Junior high school students: Eiken Grade 3, Kanken Grade 3

Eligibilities: Elementary or junior high school students who meet one of the following (1) or (2).

- (1) Students enrolled in municipal schools in the city or Gunma Kokusai Academy elementary or secondary school.
- (2) Students residing in the city but enrolled in schools outside of the city which are stipulated in the School Education Act.

Note: Computer Based Testing (CBT) tests are also applicable.

Deadline: March 31st (Tuesday), 2026 (Must arrive by this date.)

- Methods:
- (1) If students take the test as a group at school, pay half of the fee at the time of application; if they take the test at other places, fill out the application form available on the Board of Education website and send it in person or by mail to the School Education Division, Gakkou Kyouiku-Ka in the Ojima Government Building, Ojima Chousha (Address: 7370-0495 Ota-Shi Kasukawa-Cho 520) in person or by mail.
- (2) Fill out the application form on the Board of Education's website and send it to the division in person or by mail.

Note: A photocopy of the result of the test is required for both (1) and (2).
