Activities conducted by Neighborhood Council

1. Keep the community safe

Conduct crime prevention patrols and traffic safety activities, and encourage greeting in order to create a crime-free town. Check on the safety of people, serve food, and run evacuation centers in the event of a disaster.



4. Oversee children and promote their health and well-being

Watch over children and conduct greeting campaigns as part of our efforts to ensure traffic safety and crime prevention on the way to and from school, and also support activities to deepen friendships among children.



2. Protect the community's environment

Run activities to create a clean and livable community, including the maintenance and management of garbage stations, cleaning of streets and parks, clean-up campaigns, and flower-filled campaigns as well as working on waste reduction and recycling by collecting resources and managing recycling boxes.

3. Support each other in the community

Look after the elderly and disabled residents and conduct senior citizens' association programs.

5. Hold integrative activities through festivals, events and sports
