Applicants (Students) must apply to all the following conditions listed below.

- i. Students who are going to admit or currently enroll in specialized training colleges, junior college, university, etc.
- ii. Students who are academically excellent, well-motivated to study.
- iii. Students have resided (or resided) within the city for at least one year while enrolled in high school.
- iv. Parents/guardians have resided in the city for one year or more.
- v. Students who are having trouble progressing to higher education due to financial difficulties.
- vi. Applicants and their parents/guardians have no outstanding municipal tax arrears.
- vii. Students who do not receive any national grant-based scholarships or tuition fee reductions.
- viii. Students who do not receive any scholarship grants or loans administered by the city.
- ix. Students who do not receive any other scholarships.

Eligible Individuals:

Students in a university *Daigaku*, graduate school *Daigakuin*, junior college *Tanki Daigaku*, National Institute of Technology *Koutou Senmon Gakkou* (fourth year and above, and graduate programs), specialized training college *Senshu Gakkou* (postsecondary course).

Benefit Amount: 600,000-yen per year
