Fire Prevention at Home - 10 Points M Safeguarding Life -

Four Good Habits

- ✓ Never smoke in bed and never let anyone do so.
- ✓ Use heaters at a safe distance away from flammable objects.
- ✓ Never be away from stoves in use.
- Clean dust from sockets and unplug unnecessary ones.

Practice Fire Safety at home!

Six Preventive Measures

- ✓ Use heaters and cooking stoves with safety devices to prevent.
- ✓ Check **residential flame/smoke detector** regularly and replace them every 10 years to ensure early detection.
- ✓ Keep your room tidy and use flameproof bedding, clothing, and curtains to prevent the spread.
- ✓ Install **fire extinguishers** and make sure that you know how to use them to extinguish fires while they are still small.
- ✓ Always be prepared with evacuation routes and methods especially for the elderly and physically disabled.
- ✓ Participate in fire prevention drills and take other community-wide fire prevention measures.

Key Initiatives Promote the installation and maintenance of residential flame / smoke detector. **Installation is mandatory for all residences.** Install them to protect you and make sure to check them periodically.

Deduction Certificates for Year-End Adjustments and Final Income Tax Returns

The Social Insurance Premium (national pension contributions) Deduction Certificate *Shakai Hoken Ryou (Kokumin Nenkin Hokenryo) Koujo Shoumeisho* will be mailed from Japan Pension Service if you paid in national pension contributions between January 1st and September 30th in this year. The certificates are needed for your Year-End Adjustment *Nenmatsu Chousei* or Final Income Tax Returns *Kakutei Shinkoku*. Please store them in a safe place when you receive it.
