Protect Children from Child Abuse.

What is **Child Abuse**?

Physical Abuse:

Yelling, punching, kicking, violently shaking infants, burning with cigarettes, locking children out of the house, etc.

Neglect (neglecting to nurture and educate):

Not feeding sufficiently, not letting children go to school, not providing proper standards of hygiene, not providing medical care when they need, etc.

Psychological Abuse:

Yelling, using abusive language, destroying the children's self-esteem by verbally denying the children's existence or showing favoritism towards siblings, etc.

Sexual Abuse:

Forcing children to watch or conduct sexual intercourse, etc.



What should we do to prevent?

If you notice any of the following;

- ✓ I saw a child who has been **getting suspicious injuries**.
- ✓ I saw a child whose **clothes are unsanitary** and **NOT in proper conditions**.
- ✓ I often hear an **adult yelling and a child wailing**.
- ✓ I saw a baby who was **left unattended inside a vehicle**.
