Activities

1. Keep Community Safe.

Conduct crime prevention patrols and traffic safety activities, and encourage greeting in order to create a crime-free city. In the event of a disaster, check and make sure everyone is safe, serve food, and run evacuation centers.

2. Protect Community's Environment.

Run activities to create a clean and livable community, including the maintenance and management of garbage stations, cleaning of streets and parks, clean-up campaigns, and flower-filled campaigns as well as working on waste reduction and recycling by collecting resources and managing recycling boxes.

3. Support Each Other.

Look after the elderly and disabled residents and conduct senior citizens' association programs.

4. Keep Children Safe & Promote Health and Well-Being.

Watch over children and conduct greeting campaigns as part of our efforts to ensure traffic safety and crime prevention on the way to and from school, and also support activities to deepen friendships among children.

5. Engage with City.

Provide information necessary for daily life from the city through circular bulletins and other means in addition to voluntary activities.

6. Hold Integrative Activities. (Festivals, events and sports)

Interact with local people, expand friendships, and developing a sense of solidarity that is important for the safety and security of the community. Ota City holds a variety of events that promote local characteristics.
