

For Children Born Abroad:

Required Documents for Childbirth Lump-sum Allowance Application

Please prepare the following and other related documents if necessary.

1. Eligibility Certificate of National Health Insurance, or other certificate

<<Eligibility must be confirmed at the time of childbirth.>>

2. Passport of person who gave birth

Personnel must be able to confirm and check the entry/departure of the country where a child was delivered, as well as re-entry into Japan at the time of your application. If your passport is not stamped upon entry or departure, bring your boarding pass or immigration record (issued at immigration), etc. along with documents (original copy) that can verify the dates.

3. Birth Certificate (original)

A document certified by an official body that proves the birth of child.

- In the case of still births, documents that can verify them (Notification of Death, a certificate from the hospital, etc.).
- ※ **Japanese translation must be attached (translator's address, phone number, name, and inkan-seal)**
- ※ There may be additional documents requested in order to verify the written contents of your application.

4. Original copy of the (detailed receipt) medical bill of childbirth

Submit the original copy of your medical bill, etc. with the application.

- ※ **Japanese translation must be attached (translator's address, phone number, name, and seal)**
- ※ There may be additional documents requested in order to verify the written contents of your application

5. Maternal and Child Health Handbook (issued in Japan)

6. Head of the household's bank book

(A letter of proxy is required for individuals other than the head of the household)

- ※ You will be unable to receive this allowance if you leave any omissions or do not have all of the required documents. Please apply with all of the required documents, etc.

Attention

Screening processes will take a considerable amount of time.
