

## **On Demand City Minibus** (Oukagai Shi Bus)

### ■ What is the bus?

The City's on demand minibus operates primarily to support medical visits and shopping for citizens such as the elderly who face transportation difficulties.

### ■ Who can use the bus?

1. People who are 70 years old or more
2. People who have Physical Disability Certificate *Shintai Shougaiasha Techou*, Mental Disability Certificate *Seishin Shougaiasha Hoken Fukushi Techou*, Medical Treatment or Education Handbook *Ryouiku Techou*

Note: People who can get in and out of a car on their own

### ■ How to use

Where to apply: Community Centers, Regional Mobility Strategy Division (Ota City Hall 5F/Counter 55)

1. Fill out and submit the 'User Registration Application and Consent Form.'
2. Receive a Registration Certificate by mail (it takes 2 to 3 weeks).
3. Make a reservation. (Online or phone)

### ■ When to use

Service Available: Weekdays from 7:00 to 16:00

Not Available: Weekends, public holidays, year-end and new year holiday (December 29<sup>th</sup> to January 3<sup>rd</sup>)

### ■ How much

One way fare: 200-yen or 300-yen
