(There were suspicious arson cases in your neighborhood recently.)

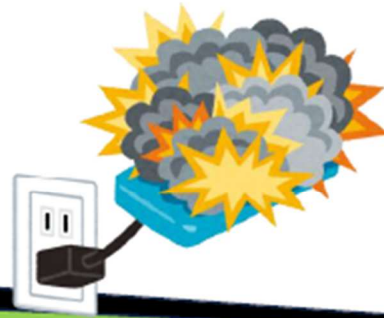
What should be done in order to avoid that to happen to protect our house?

Answer 3



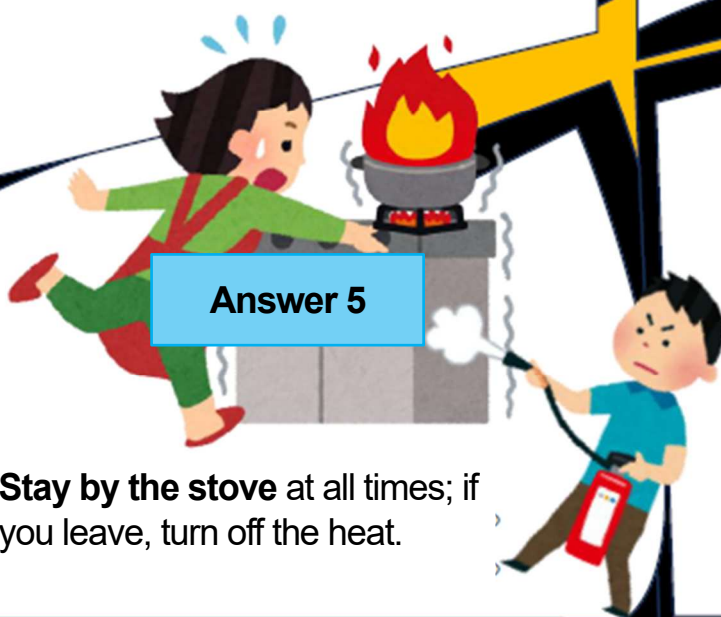
Never leave it in the car on hot days.
