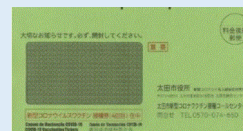
## 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Dose

Those vaccinated by February 2022: End of September

Those vaccinated in March 2022 or later: Dispatched sequentially

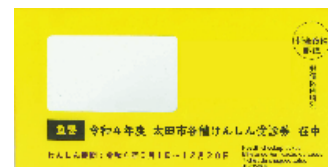

## Take Special Health Checkup by December 20<sup>th</sup> (Tue.), 2022.

Special checkups include blood and blood pressure measurement, urine, physical measurement, and medical examination / consultation which takes about one hour. There are approximately 2 months left of the free period, so please make sure to take one by the date above.

## Chest X-ray (Tuberculosis / Lung Cancer) Group Health Exams

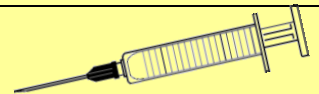

- **Eligible persons:** Individuals aged 40 and over as of March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023
- **What to bring:** Consultation tickets "Jushinken" and barcode stickers
- **Fees (Co-payment):** chest x-ray 500-yen (free for individuals 65 and over);  
sputum test 500-yen (free for individuals 70 and over)

※ Individuals who are not feeling well, have traveled abroad in the last two weeks, have contacted any COVID-19 patients (including suspicious cases), etc. or those with insulin pumps or continuous glucose meters attached.

## 1,000-yen Influenza Vaccine



### Vaccination Period: Until January 10<sup>th</sup> (Tuesday), 2023

**Eligibility:** Applicants who registered in the city on the vaccination day and meet any of the conditions in the table below.

**Number of Vaccination:** Once (Twice for individuals who are under age of 13 with severe disability)

**How to receive:** Bring your pre-vaccination screening questionnaire "Yoshinhyou" at a medical facility conducting vaccination. Note: Please read the instruction on the form carefully beforehand.

Age 65 or over	Born on/before December 31, 1957	Vaccination forms will be sent by post.	<b>For individuals who receive social welfare</b> , free of charge if you apply when you are vaccinated. If you wish to receive the vaccination in a medical facility located outside of the prefecture (excl. Ashikaga City, Tochigi Prefecture), please contact one of the Health "Hoken" Centers beforehand. (Advanced application is needed.)
Age 60 to 64	Individuals who have severe illnesses for heart, kidney or respiratory, or immunodeficiency disorders due to HIV.	Please consult with your primary doctor and contact one of the Health "Hoken" Centers beforehand if you wish to receive the vaccination. Vaccination forms will be sent by post after contacting the center.	
Individuals who have severe disability	Holders of Physical Disability Certificate "Shintai Shougaiisha Techou" Level 1 or 2, the Medical Treatment and Education Handbook "Ryouiku Techou" A, or Mental Disability Certificate "Seishin Shougaiisha Hoken Fukushi Techou" Level 1	Please contact one of the Health "Hoken" Centers beforehand. Forms will be issued at a Health "Hoken" Center or sent by post. Or visit a Health "Hoken" Center with your certificate/handbook.	If you wish to receive the vaccination in a medical facility located outside of the city, please contact one of the Health "Hoken" Centers beforehand.
