COVID-19 Vaccine (for 4th dose) in Ota City

Eligibility: Persons who falls under one of the following and 5 months or more have passed since the 3rd dose.

- ① 60 years or older
- 2 18 to 59 years of age with underlying disease
- 3 18 to 59 years of age, recognised by the doctor to be at high risk of aggravation by becoming infected with COVID-19



When you fall under ② or ③: it will be necessary to request the issuance of the 4th dose ticket, except for those who made this procedure for the 1st and 2nd dose.

Individual Vaccination

Note: Please check whether it is acceptable in advance if the 4th vaccination is available at a different institution from the 3rd.


