

● Notice from Tax Office

(英語版)

Filing your tax return by e-Tax from your home is recommended in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Why don't you file your tax return on your smartphone with your Individual Number (My-Number) Card?

● If you access to the “Final Tax Return, etc.*” page on the National Tax Agency website through your smartphone, you can apply for your tax return on a dedicated screen for it. In addition, when you scan the withholding tax slip “*Gensen Choushuuhyo*” with the camera function of your smartphone, the amount listed on it is automatically reflected on the input screen making the preparation of tax returns very easy and convenient.

● Income tax refunds can be filed for five years (e.g., from January 1st, 2022 to December 31st, 2026 for the year 2021). Please avoid busy times and file between April and December.

Relatives between the ages of 30 and 69 who reside outside of Japan will be excluded from the deduction from 2023, in principle. Remittances of 380,000-yen or more per dependent must be made between January and December in a year in order to receive the deduction for dependents.
