If you earn a salary, you are eligible for exemptions in your employer's year-end adjustment.

Employees are eligible for exemptions such as spouse deductions, special spouse deductions, dependents deduction and insurance premium deduction in your employer's year-end adjustment "Nenmatsu Chosei." Please submit a declaration of exemption for dependents, etc. to your employer in order to receive the correct exemptions. If you obtain these exemptions in the year-end adjustment, you do not need to file your final income tax return "Kakutei Shinkoku."

In addition, you can receive such exemptions by having the year-end adjustment done again (re-adjustment) if you find any changes in your dependent deductions or any omissions in exemptions after the year-end adjustment.

Use your smartphone from home and apply through e-Tax to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

If you access to the "Final Tax Return (etc.) Corner*" page on the National Tax Agency website through your smartphone, you can apply for your tax return on a dedicated screen for it.

In addition, when you scan the withholding tax slip "Gensen Choushuuhyo" with the camera function of your smartphone, the amount listed on it is automatically reflected on the input screen making the preparation of tax returns very easy and convenient.
