Note 1- The first and second vaccinations are booked as a set; the second vaccination is given three weeks after the first, at the same time and place.

Note 2- For more information, please refer to the letter enclosed with the vaccination coupons.

Eligible Persons: 12 years old or older and registered as a resident of Ota City (minors, under 20, must be accompanied by a guardian.) What to Bring: Vaccination coupons, prevaccination screening questionnaire, I.D. (e.g. Driver's License Card, Health Insurance Card, Resident "Zairyu" Card) If you are under medication, please bring Medicine Book "Okusuri Techo." (Bring

the medicines that you take instead if you do not have one.)

Note 3- Use masks and wear clothes that allow to access your shoulders on vaccination day.

To all who are turning 12 years old: Vaccination coupons are sent in the month following your birthdays. Please check the enclosed documents and come with your parent / guardian on your vaccination day.

Vaccination interval with other vaccines: COVID-19 vaccines and other vaccines should be spaced two weeks apart from each other after receiving one of the vaccines. Please be careful if you are considering getting other vaccinations.

Gunma Vaccine Techo

This can be used to apply for the "Aikyo Gunma Project" and the "Gunma Go To Eat." Please complete the procedure through online "LINE Gunma-Ken Digital Madoguchi." Subsidy for Wigs and Breast Prostheses

In order to support the social participation of cancer patients / survivors and help recovery, we will subsidize part of the purchase cost.

Eligibility: People who meet all of the following criteria

- Registered as a resident of the city and having been recorded in the city's basic resident register for at least one year on the date of application for the subsidy
- Undergone or are currently undergoing cancer treatments
- Purchased wigs or breast prosthetic devices for hair loss or mastectomy due to cancer treatments
- ✓ No delinquency in paying municipal inhabitant tax

Maximum subsidy amount Wigs, etc. - 30,000 yen, Breast Prostheses - 10,000 yen

<u>Number of times</u>- One time per person <u>Application period</u> - Within one year from the date of purchase <u>Application</u>*1 - Prepare required documents and go to one of the health centers.

National Fire Prevention Autumn Campaign (until 15 Nov.)

Fires are more likely to occur during this part of the season. Make sure you take the proper precautions in order to protect yourself and your belongings.

Home Fire Prevention- 10 Points for Safeguarding Life

Four Good Habits

- ✓ Never smoke in bed and never let anyone do so.
- ✓ Use heaters at a safe distance <u>away</u> from flammable objects.
- \checkmark Shut off the cooking stoves in your kitchen anytime you are away.
- ✓ Clean outlets of dust and unplug unnecessary ones.

Six Preventive Measures

- ✓ Use heaters and cooking stoves with safety devices to prevent.
- ✓ Check residential fire alarms regularly and replace them every 10 years to ensure early detection.
- ✓ Keep your room tidy and use flameproof bedding, clothing, and curtains to prevent the spread.
- Install fire extinguishers and make sure that you know how to use them to extinguish fires while they are still small.
- Always be prepared with evacuation routes and methods especially for the elderly and physically disabled.
- Participate in fire prevention drills and take other community-wide fire prevention measures.
