You receive an envelope from the municipality (city/town/village) in which you are registered.

Vaccination ticket called “*Sesshu-ken*” is in it.

I received vaccination coupon/ticket in the mail from the city/town/village hall. What should I do?

A

1. Reserve the vaccination site where you want to receive the vaccine.

It is written in the letter how to make a reservation.



2. Receive the vaccine shot at the site where you made the reservation.

You will get injected on the shoulder. Please wear clothes that allow you to show your shoulders and come to the vaccination site.

Things to bring to the vaccination site

- Vaccination ticket called “*Sesshu-ken*”
- ID (Passport, residence card called “*Zairyu-card*,” etc.)
- Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire for COVID-19 vaccine called *Yoshin-hyo*. You need to fill it out completely.)



3. The number of injections is 2 times in total

- ① About vaccination coupon/ticket, the sites to get vaccinated, reservation, etc. . . .

- ② About the vaccine, side effects after receiving the vaccine, etc.
